

Lobo Senior Scholarship Criteria

- Applicant must complete LOBO Band Booster scholarship application (see attached).
- Must turn in scholarship application two weeks prior to band Spring awards banquet (TBA each year). This deadline is not negotiable.
- Applicants must provide a list of individual awards, honors, or accomplishments they have received while in the band program. This list should include band (All-Region, Solo & Ensemble, etc.), as well as non-band related awards.
- Applicant must attach 500 word essay to application as to how band has helped them and will help them better themselves.
- Applicant must attach two teacher recommendations to application. The band directors can not give recommendations for this scholarship.
- Applicant must not have a negative balance in their band booster account.
- If awarded scholarship, recipient must provide proof of enrollment to a college, university or vocational school to qualify for scholarship with check to be held in trust until such proof is provided. This will be held for one academic year after scholarship is awarded.
- Applicants must complete 80 hours (not all in one year – this comes out to 20 hours a year) of community service. 40 (forty) hours must be completed as an LEISD student in surrounding cities that include LEISD boundary and 40 (forty) hours may be completed outside surrounding counties. Community services are broken down into categories. Band boosters will provide a document for students to keep their hours. Organizations they do service hours for must sign the document. Examples are as follows and must be documented:
 - School – Picking up litter after a game, working concession stands without payment going into student account, helping with Brent, Powell and Lakeside Junior High band student programs per band director(s), reading to students, etc.
 - Christmas nativity, Fall Festival.
 - Group – As a team, the band students plant a flower bed together and each band student donates 4 hours of time, each band student will receive credit.
 - Church – Vacation Bible School volunteers, vacuuming, cleaning yard area, for time worked, local library, clean up Little Elm Park or Beard Park, etc.
 - Note – Fundraising hours are different and are counted as community service hours if it is a LOBO Band Booster approved fundraiser and money does not go into student's account.
- There are no penalties or exceptions for newcomers to Little Elm who have been in band in other high schools.
- If a band student quits or is dismissed (for disciplinary reasons at any time) their senior year, they are ineligible for a scholarship from the LOBO Band Boosters.
- Applicant must be passing all classes with an average GPA of 2.75 to qualify for a LOBO Band Booster scholarship.
- Early graduates and scheduling conflicts will be on a case by case basis for a LOBO Band Booster scholarship.
